# Who Will You Serve

Exodus 32:15-26

<sup>8</sup>They have turned aside quickly out of the way which I commanded them: they have made them a molten calf, and have worshipped it, and have sacrificed thereunto, and said, These be thy gods, O Israel, which have brought thee up out of the land of Egypt.

Exodus 32:8

<sup>10</sup>Thus saith the LORD unto this people,  
Thus have they *loved to wander...*

Jeremiah 14:10

<sup>15</sup>And Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the testimony were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written.

Exodus 32:15

<sup>19</sup>Now we know that what things soever the law saith, it saith to them who are under the law: that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God.

Romans 3:19

<sup>20</sup>Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin.

Romans 3:20

<sup>20</sup>And Moses said unto the people, Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that his fear may be before your faces, that ye sin not.

Exodus 20:20

<sup>23</sup>Ye shall not make with me gods of silver,  
neither shall ye make unto you gods of  
gold.

Exodus 20:23

<sup>24</sup>An altar of earth thou shalt make unto me, and shalt sacrifice thereon thy burnt offerings, and thy peace offerings, thy sheep, and thine oxen: in all places where I record my name I will come unto thee, and I will bless thee.

<sup>16</sup>And the tables were the work of God, and the writing was the writing of God, graven upon the tables.

Exodus 32:16

<sup>6</sup>The words of the LORD are pure words:  
as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified  
seven times.

Psalms 12:6

<sup>7</sup>Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever.

Psalms 12:7

<sup>4</sup>And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power:

1 Corinthians 2:4

<sup>5</sup>That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God.

1 Corinthians 2:5

<sup>6</sup>Howbeit we speak wisdom among them that are perfect: yet not the wisdom of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought:

1 Corinthians 2:6

<sup>7</sup>But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory:

1 Corinthians 2:7

<sup>8</sup>Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

1 Corinthians 2:8

<sup>9</sup>But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him.

1 Corinthians 2:9

<sup>10</sup>But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

1 Corinthians 2:10

<sup>11</sup>For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.

1 Corinthians 2:11

<sup>12</sup>Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

1 Corinthians 2:12

<sup>13</sup>Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

1 Corinthians 2:13

<sup>14</sup>But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.

1 Corinthians 2:14

<sup>17</sup>And when Joshua heard the noise of the people as they shouted, he said unto Moses, There is a noise of war in the camp.

Exodus 32:17

<sup>18</sup>And he said, It is not the voice of them that shout for mastery, neither is it the voice of them that cry for being overcome: but the noise of them that sing do I hear.

Exodus 32:18

<sup>1</sup>From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members?

James 4:1

<sup>15</sup>Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1 John 2:15

<sup>16</sup>For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

1 John 2:16

<sup>6</sup>In those days there was no king in Israel,  
but every man did that which was right in  
his own eyes.

Judges 17:6

<sup>12</sup>There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

Proverbs 14:12

<sup>19</sup>And it came to pass, as soon as he came  
nigh unto the camp, that he saw the calf,  
and the dancing: and Moses' anger waxed  
hot, and he cast the tables out of his  
hands, and brake them beneath the  
mount.

<sup>33</sup>But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

Jeremiah 31:33

<sup>14</sup>For when the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves:

<sup>15</sup>Which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;)

Romans 2:15

<sup>20</sup>And he took the calf which they had made, and burnt it in the fire, and ground it to powder, and strawed it upon the water, and made the children of Israel drink of it.

Exodus 32:20

<sup>8</sup>Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ,

Philippians 3:8

<sup>21</sup> And Moses said unto Aaron, What did this people unto thee, that thou hast brought so great a sin upon them?

Exodus 32:21

<sup>22</sup>And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they are set on mischief.

Exodus 32:22

<sup>23</sup>For they said unto me, Make us gods,  
which shall go before us: for as for this  
Moses, the man that brought us up out of  
the land of Egypt, we wot not what is  
become of him.

Exodus 32:23

<sup>24</sup>And I said unto them, Whosoever hath any gold, let them break it off. So they gave it me: then I cast it into the fire, and there came out this calf.

<sup>22</sup>Lying lips are abomination to the LORD:  
but they that deal truly are his delight.

Proverbs 12:22

<sup>2</sup>All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes; but the LORD weigheth the spirits.

Proverbs 16:2

<sup>12</sup>There is a way which seemeth right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

Proverbs 14:12

<sup>8</sup>For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.
